
Window Film Cleaning Instructions

Please note that during the process of installing your window film, a small amount of water has been used to assist the positioning of the film. This helps to disperse any air bubbles and allows the film to be applied smoothly.



During installation, 95% of the water has been removed, but the remainder has to dry out naturally. During the drying out period, you may notice small blisters appearing or sometimes the film takes on a hazy appearance, this is quite normal, and will disappear after it has dried out completely.

The film usually dries out after approximately 14 days but this period will vary due to condition or the type of film applied. During this time we advise that the film is not disturbed in any way.

After the film has dried, it is advisable that the cleaning process is carried out with care. Clean sponges, and clean cloths are recommended, water that is not contaminated must also be used. Ammonia based, or any cleaners that contain abrasive material must not be used, as these may damage the film.

The application of adhesive tape or stickers is not recommended.

The small margin around the film is a normal part of the installation process and is part of the manufacturer guarantee.
